Cover letters are often required when submitting an English language scientific paper. To be effective, these letters must persuade editors to send the manuscript for peer review within a restricting word limit. In this seminar, an academic publishing trainer & consultant will discuss cover letter composition, persuasive writing techniques, and effective responses to peer review comments.

After the main presentation, the URA Office will briefly introduce a new tool that allows researchers to perform a self-analysis of journals that may be predatory in nature.
